FROM THE BOARD:

- Membership has increased to 256.
- Pool Progress: \$4000 of the \$5000 amount budgeted to paint the pool will be saved due to in-house labor. Some of the savings will be applied to concession stand remodeling and improvement.
- Non-Resident membership privileges were discussed. A concrete proposal regarding this will be presented next month.
- Purchase of POS system has been deferred due to immediate need of kitchen equipment priorities. The Board approved the purchase of a sandwich/salad prep box not to exceed \$1500.
- Driving range safety concerns were discussed. Suggested parameters will be formulated and brought back to the Board next month.
- Written Golf Pro, Pool and Entertainment Committee reports were circulated and reviewed.
- Jerry and Diane Rash, Allan Atkins and Dominic and Kristan Whiston were approved for membership. Memberships for Pat and Connie Benson, Mike and Kim Bross, Jim Mosley and John Bier have been renewed.
- Board approval was given to allow prospective members to play golf with greens fees waived at the End-of-Spring Fling May 31st.
- Two policies were approved. One concerned barring employees from being members during their employment and one requiring any capital project over \$1000 to be competitively bid.
- Long-range planning meeting is scheduled for June 19 at 6 p.m.
- Bylaw changes will be submitted at a special shareholders' meeting this fall. It is the Board's intent that the only agenda item at the annual meeting will be election of new Board members.
- Next Board meeting is scheduled for June 13, 2008.

2008 McDonald's KIDS IN MOTION Golf Tournament

The 2008 Kids in Motion Golf Tournament, sponsored by McDonald's and the Hannibal Country Club, is scheduled for Monday, July 21, at HCC. Registration, a silent auction and lunch begins at 11:30 a.m., followed by a 1 p.m. tee time.

The format is a four-person scramble (men, women or any combination) with a maximum of 18 teams. Proceeds go to the Kids in Motion program, which is under the umbrella of Douglass Community Services, Inc.

Kids in Motion is a pre-employment program targeting at-risk kids in Hannibal. Program founder Bob Gilstrap said, "We have helped hundreds of kids during the past dozen summers. I hope everyone will come out and support this event. It will be a lot of fun and will benefit a very worthy program."

There are several participation levels. The fee for a single golfer is \$75, which includes golf, cart, lunch, beverages and gifts. A team foursome is \$300, which has the same benefits as a single golfer. A K.I.M. Help Package can be purchased for \$50, which includes 2 pay it forwards, 25 feet of string and 2 mulligans.

Special features include a \$10,000 hole-in-one opportunity! Golfers can rent a golf pro for a shot, and there will be awards for longest drive and closest to the pin. Prizes will be awarded to the top teams.

Sponsorships are available and silent auction items are needed. Cost to sponsor a hole is \$100.
